14 July	<p>Grab Singapore's 2030 Transport Sustainability Goal</p> <p>Grab Singapore has committed to operate a full fleet running on cleaner energy by 2030. This goal is part of the broader GrabForGood initiative that seeks to positively impact three core groups – People, Partners and the Planet. As one of its first steps, Grab has unveiled two programmes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• JustGrab Green: A new transport type, which is serviced by a fleet comprising electric or hybrid vehicles of minimally Vehicle Emissions Scheme A2 band. Compared to a regular vehicle running on petrol, carbon emissions can be reduced by an estimated 55% with a hybrid or electric vehicle.• Green Programme: Passengers can opt in to turn on this feature and pay a nominal S\$0.10 when they book any ride. To encourage consumers to be part of this initiative, Grab will match the \$0.10 contribution for up to three million rides.
